WMTS presents broad array of products, services

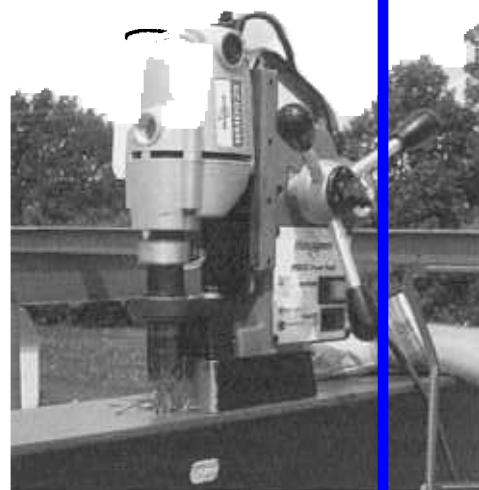
